Gentleness

Self Control

In Galatians 5:22-23, The Apostle Paul concludes his list of fruit of the Spirit with selfcontrol. Due to the human condition, we can all be susceptible to negative impulses and qualities. Deep, intimate, connection with God develops the power of God to identify and overcome areas of weakness.
